Super Summer Participant Rules and Contract

1. Students and Team Leaders are not allowed to leave campus, from time of check-in until check-out on Friday.
2. Late arrivals and/or early checkouts are not permitted. Students and Team Leaders must attend all scheduled activities and school sessions.
3. Students and Team Leaders are not allowed to ride in any vehicle. You may not use cars, buses, vans, motorcycles, skateboards, or skates on campus.
4. Students and Team Leaders must go straight to their classroom and must leave the building when the class is over. No loitering.
5. Anyone who is ill or injured must be either in the Super Summer office, nurse's office, medical clinic or hospital.
6. Students and Team Leaders must indicate what medications they will use at Super Summer. Medication must not be shared with anyone else.
7. Students and Team Leaders must be in the dorm each night, Monday through Thursday, by 11:00pm. Lights out at 11:30PM
8. Under no circumstances are girls to be in boys' rooms or boys in girls' rooms. This includes hallways outside these dorm rooms, too. No exceptions!
9. Drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, any type of paint, firearms, knives, or any other kind of weapon, or fireworks are not allowed. Also, do not bring portable music players, radios (including clock radios), televisions, computers, cell phones or any other type of electronic games or equipment.
10. Clothing should reflect a godly attitude, and not divert the attention of those around you from their focus on God's word and his purpose in their lives. Casual clothing is acceptable during all activities at Super Summer. Sleeveless articles will not be allowed for either boys or girls. All shorts and skirts must be no shorter than fingertip length with arms and hands straight down at sides while standing. Low-cut dress necklines and sheer clothing are also not allowed. Persons wearing clothing determined to be too short or too revealing will be asked to change. Repeated disregard for dressing appropriately may be considered a violation of the rules. Remember that you will be seated in small groups (usually on the ground) several times throughout the day (even after the worship service), and choose clothing that will allow you to sit comfortably during those times.
11. Students and Team Leaders must wear name tags at all times. It is your ID badge allowing you entrance into campus buildings. The name tag also shows Super Summer staff and university police that you are authorized to be on campus.
12. Refrain from Public Displays of Affection (PDA) with girlfriends or boyfriends.
13. Ordering food to be delivered on campus is forbidden.
14. Super Summer participants must obey university rules and regulations.

I am a dedicated Christian, and sign this contract committing myself to attend all school sessions, be on time, and participate in every activity planned for me by Super Summer staff. I understand that if I fail to use good judgment and common sense in following the rules listed above, I will be dismissed from Super Summer and returned home at my own expense.

Medication Release/Administration Form

Super Summer requires that all students who need medication during their attendance at Super Summer must do the following:

2. Bring the medication in the original bottle (prescription or over-the-counter), properly labeled as prescribed by law.
3. Present this form and the medication indicated to the Super Summer Medical Staff upon arrival on campus.
